The room will be open for staging between 8:30am and 10am Judging will commence at 10:15am prompt, no entries can be accepted once judging has begun. Only Judges & Stewards allowed in the room while judging takes place, Judges decisions are final. Any complaint should be put in writing to Lesley or Audrey.


