

Silloth Flying Club

The Pigeon Club in Silloth is one of the oldest societies in the town. It was founded over 100 years ago and is still active today. Twenty years ago the Pigeon Club had 20 members, today there are 6 members, five of whom are active. This is a sign of the times, the younger generation have a host of other things to do, computers, play station etc. whereas years ago hobbies were more family orientated and thus Pigeon Racing was often a family affair, father/son etc.

The decline in membership is nationwide, with very few younger people participating in which is a fascinating hobby. Silloth Flying Club is a member of the Derwent Valley Federation, which covers the west coast from Harrington down to Silloth. There are 15 clubs affiliated to the federation, which in turn is affiliated to the Cumbrian Combine, which has a total of 4 Federators as members. All Club Federator Combines are members of the Royal Pigeon Racing Association, of which have the Queen as patron. The Royal Lofts are situated at Sandringham and are cared for by a manager.

Pigeon Racing has a strict set of rules which all organisations must adhere to. The rules are set by the R.P.R.A. and all organisations.

Pigeon racing is a fascinating hobby, the fancier is not only the



breeder but the trainer and owner of these 'athletes of the sky'. It is wrong to confuse a Racing Pigeon with those you see in the streets, public parks etc. there are no comparisons. We all marvel how 14 - 16 oz. of feather and muscle negotiate vast distances and find their way home, e.g.. from Barcelona and various race points in France. Having raced pigeons almost 40 years it still gives me a thrill to see our pigeons arrive home from a race whether it be 50 miles or 500 miles.

Silloth Flying Club although now few in number is still very competitive and have achieved some marvellous results over the years. The latest being W. Minnican & Son winning the Cumbria Combine from Falaise in France last year, a distance of 434 miles.

Our season commences in mid April and continues each Saturday through to mid September. Our first race is from Leyland (Lancs) a distance of 85 miles increasing weekly until the final old bird race from Nantes in France, which is 532 miles.

In mid July young bird racing commences, these are for pigeons born in 2003, each bird has its own metal ring which identifies it with the year of its birth and who the owner is. Our young birds commence racing from Flookbury, which is 51 miles and following on with a series of 9 races ending mid September at Cheltenham which is 212 miles. So far this season we have had 3 races for old birds, two from Leyland and one


This was a very fast race with less than twenty seconds for the first 6 pigeons to arrive home, they were reaching speeds of almost 70mph. The winning bird took 1hr 41mins 5secs.

Our Pigeons leave Silloth each Friday night on the Derwent Valley Federator transporter, which holds approximately

4,000 pigeons. The birds are collected from our headquarters in Silloth Social Club between 9:30 & 9:45pm each Friday and travel through the night to the various race points.
