May proved to be a busy month with twelve ships visiting the port.

The first vessel was the LILIANA with a cargo of paper pulp from Antwerp, closely followed by the VINETA with fertilizer from Safi in Morocco.

Next was the SEA HUMBER also with fertilizer from Rotterdam and the large molasses tanker APACHE-1 from Schveningen in Holland.

The large Russian ship BALTISKIY-111 from Tallin in Estonia and the FREYA from Sfax in Tunisia arrived together with fertilizer and the BEN ELLAN brought a cargo of wheat from Liverpool. The SCOT

VENTURE brought a large cargo of paper pulp from Flushing and the BALTISKIY-110 brought a cargo of fertilizer from Ternuzen.

The month ended with three cargoes of wheat on the BOISTEROUS from Bonnieres in France, LADOGA-12 from Volgast in Germany and the BEN ELLAN again from Liverpool. A busy month with lots of variety.


