125th Anniversary



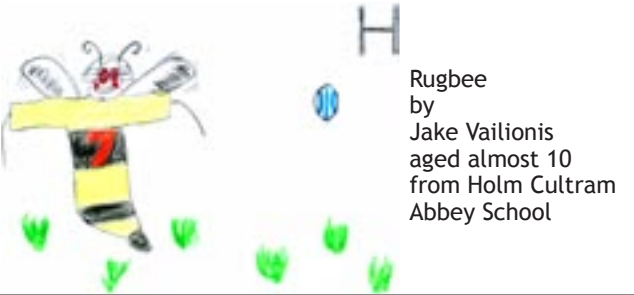
