## Charity Sky Dive

Michelle 'Drops In' To Support Cumbria  
Flood Recovery Fund Appeal



Michelle Bowes took to the skies recently to undertake a sponsored tandem sky dive in aid of the Cumbria Flood Recovery Fund Appeal, administered by Cumbria Community Foundation (CCF).

Michelle said 'It was out of this world, I would recommend it to everyone! I jumped from 14,000ft and the free fall lasted for about 50 seconds. The views were amazing, on the descent I had a fabulous view of the lake district including Windermere and Coniston.'

Andrew Beeforth, Director of the Foundation said 'So many people have done so much to raise money for the fund. One man sold his last Rolo on e-Bay, a little girl raised £80 by asking everyone invited to her ninth birthday party to make a donation to the fund and now Michelle has risked life and limb to help out.' Andrew added 'The Appeal Fund is still making grants and our monies are nearly spent up, so all new donations are very welcome.'

Launched on 9th January 2005 The Appeal has raised £748,888 against an initial target of £500,000. As a result of the Appeal £602,578 has been distributed. Forty Seven awards have been made to groups and 696 awards have been made to individuals and

families, benefiting 1,503 people.

The Cumbria Flood Recovery Fund has been short listed for a major national prize from the Charity Awards 2005. The awards are the UK charity sector's most prestigious annual award scheme and recognise excellence in the management of charities. Trustees and staff from Cumbria Community Foundation will attend the award ceremony on Thursday 16th June. The judges of the competition said they had short listed the Fund because of the 'speed, community engagement and delivery on the ground'.
