#### PNEUMOCOCCAL VACCINATION

What is Pneumococcal disease?

Pneumococcal disease is caused by the bacterium Streptococcus pneumonia. It is the most common cause of pneumonia and it can cause a number of other serious illnesses, including septicaemia and meningitis, which can be fatal. This risk increases substantially after the age of 65. If you are over 65 years of age you will shortly be receiving an invitation to attend the surgery to have a Pneumococcal vaccination. Unlike the flu vaccination the Pneumococcal vaccination can be given all year round.

If you are 65 years or over or suffer from chronic respiratory disease, including asthma, chronic heart disease, renal disease, or diabetes you are invited to attend either the surgery or attend one of the following clinics being held at:
