Dog Fouling Prosecution

A Workington woman has been prosecuted by Allerdale Borough Council for failing to clean up after her dog fouled.

Paula Waugh, of Grasmere Avenue, Workington, was fined £50 and ordered to pay £25 costs by West Allerdale Magistrates on 7th February after she failed to pay a fixed penalty fine of £50.

The Court heard that on the afternoon of 3rd November, Allerdale's Environmental Wardens witnessed Ms Waugh's Staffordshire Bull Terrier fouling the grass area next to the cycle track at Grasmere Avenue. Ms Waugh failed to clean up after her dog.

A fixed penalty notice was hand delivered to Ms Waugh's home but was not paid. Despite a reminder letter being sent to Ms Waugh on 23rd November, the fixed penalty remained unpaid.

Ms Waugh pleaded guilty at the hearing.

December was a quiet month with five vessels visiting the port, the first being the KORALLE with fertilizer from Ijmuiden followed by the BEN VARREY with wheat from Liverpool. The HENNY then brought another cargo of fertilizer from Ijmuiden and the tanker ELLEN THERESA brought a cargo of molasses from Bremen in Germany. Finally the ANDRINA F brought a cargo of paper pulp from Spain.

January was quite a busy month with seven vessels, the first was the SEA KESTREL with fertilizer from Ijmuiden followed by the tanker ELLEN THERESA with molasses from Amsterdam. The SCOT PIONEER then brought paper pulp from Antwerp and the HOO FALCON had a cargo of fertilizer from Ijmuiden. The KORIANGI then brought wheat from Germany, the FRI STREAM had fertilizer from Norway and finally the BEN VARREY brought wheat from Seaforth Dock, Liverpool.
