Calling All Caterers

WARNING TO FOOD BUSINESS **PROPRIETORS**

ALLERDALE Borough Council's **Environmental Health** Unit would like to remind all food business proprietors of the dangers of using raw eggs in some forms of food preparation.

The warning follows the successful prosecution of Hundith Hill Hotel Limited in connection with a salmonella food poisoning outbreak at the premises on 2 July 2006. The Hotel was fined £12,000 with £1,500 costs awarded.

In particular, the Council would like to stress that caterers should not use raw eggs in any food that will not be cooked, or will only be lightly cooked.

Examples of such foods include home-made mayonnaise, mousse and other desserts containing eggs. Pasteurised eggs should be used in such cases.

The advice on the use of raw eggs was initially issued by the Department of Health in 1993 and subsequently by the Government's Food Standards Agency.

Maureen Rourke, Allerdale Borough **Council Executive** Member with responsibility for the Environment, said: "Allerdale Borough Council, together with the Health Protection Agency, acted quickly to investigate and control this salmonella outbreak.

"The hotel stopped using raw eggs as an ingredient in uncooked menu dishes immediately. This case emphasises the fact that caterers are not to use raw eggs in any dish that will not be cooked or only lightly cooked.

"It is not possible to guarantee that any egg will be free from salmonella, whatever the source or brand."
